# Re: STRIKE ON 26<sup>th</sup> NOV.2020.AGAINST ATTACK ON LABOUR RIGHTS ON CALL OF CTUs . AIRRBOF WILL BE EXTENDING MORAL SUPPORT.

Dear friends,

The proposed nationwide General Strike of central Trade Unions (CTUs) on the 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2020, is a very important strike action since the Government is moving wholesale to attack the workers and working class rights as a whole. UFRRBU has taken a decision to participate in the Strike. Members of our one of the constituent, **AIRRBOF**, will be extending moral support only to the Strike.

- In Banking sector, we are already facing various challenges due to Government's policies. By the unwarranted and forcible merger of Banks, we now see the move the close down large number of Branches and steep reduction in job opportunities.
- Recruitments are shrinking and managements are reluctant to go for adequate recruitments.
- Attempts are nakedly afoot to outsource all our jobs. Here and there
  they started outsourcing security staff and housekeeping staff, slowly
  started employing Bank Mitras and Business Correspondents to
  undertake normal banking services, and now, they are starting
  Doorstep banking by employing private agencies.
- Privatising our Banks is another serious agenda before them now. By this our Banks will be handed over to the corporate defaulters instead of taking action to recover the bad loans.
- Scrapping NPS which is one of the important issues in the Strike is an important demand for bank employees also.

CENTRAL TRADE UNIONS have taken up general issues along with our issues broadly and prepared common Charter of demanded as follows:

#### WHAT ARE OUR DEMADNS NOW:

- Cash transfer of Rs 7,500 per month for all non income tax paying families
- 10 kg free ration per person per month to all needy
- Expansion of MGNREGA to provide 200 days' work in a year in rural areas at enhanced wages; extension of employment quarantee to urban areas
- Withdraw all anti farmer laws and anti worker labour codes
- Stop privatisation of public sector including the financial sector and stop corporatisation of Govt run manufacturing and service entities like Railways, Ordinance Factories, Ports etc.
- Withdraw the draconian circular on forced premature retirement of Government & PSU Employees
- Provide Pension to all, scrap NPS and restore earlier Pension, improve EPS-95

MOBILISE IN MILLIONS – MILITANT STRIKE ON 26<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER: This convention calls upon the working class to organise joint state/ district/ industry/sectoral level conventions, physically wherever possible, online otherwise, before the end of October 2020; to conduct an extensive campaign on the adverse impact of the labour codes on the workers down to the grass roots level up to mid-November and for the one day country wide general strike on 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2020.

Let it be known that this One Day Strike is in preparation for more intense, more tenacious and longer struggles that lie ahead.

**WE APPEAL – MAKE A STRIKE A SUCCESS:** The Convention calls upon all the working people, whether unionised or not, affiliated or independent, whether from organised sector or unorganised sector, to intensify the united struggle against the anti-people, anti-worker, anti-farmer and anti-national policies of the Govt and make the call for countrywide general strike on 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2020 a total success.
