Greetings from All India Bank Officers' Confederation (AIBOC), the apex trade union of officers in the banking industry.

You are aware that the salary revision of the officers and employees of the RRBs on account of  $8_{th}$  Joint Note/  $11_{th}$  Bipartite Settlement was finally decided through Department of Financial Services vide memo F no.-8/1/2021/RRB dated 01.04.2021. The managements of the various RRBs were directly advised to settle and implement revision in salary and allowances and Part I of the other allowances, whereas Part II of the other allowances were to be decided and released by the sponsor banks in consultation with the concerned RRBs.

2. It is pertinent to point out that while some PSBs (including SBI) have responded immediately and have released the benefits, some are yet to act upon the advisory. We would like to bring to your kind attention that till date Part II of the other allowances have not been released to the officers working in RRBs sponsored by your esteemed institution. You will surely agree that sufficient time has since been elapsed and the delay in release of the legitimate benefits have caused widespread resentment and angst amongst the officers of the RRBs who have been providing yeoman service to nation during the testing times.

We, therefore, solicit the personal intervention of your good office to address the issue and ensure that the officers of RRBs are not denied equity and justice.
